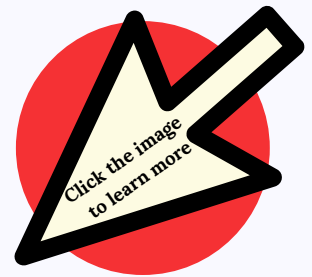




Inspiring Journals & Fun Pens

Inspirational Apparel

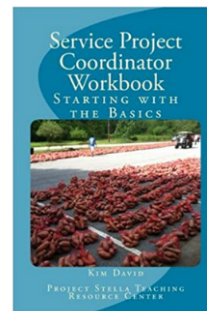
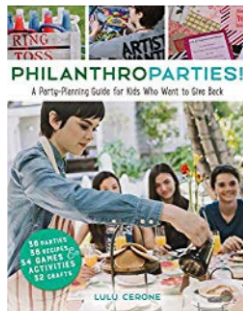
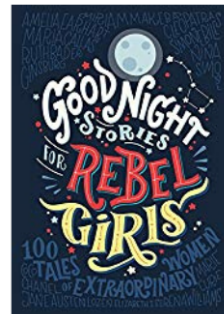
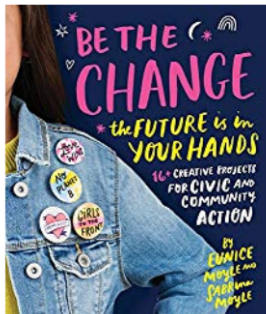

If your child wants to put her plan into action, art supplies provide a way to make posters or displays to share the message. Art supplies can be used for service projects and doing acts of kindness.

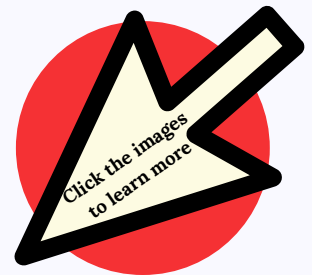




Inspiring Decor

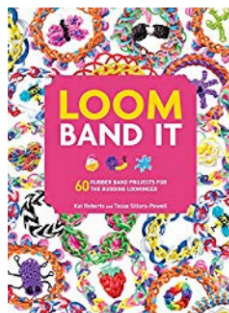
Encouragement and inspiration can come from many different places and surrounding your child with messages in her room or throughout the house can keep her positive energy strong.

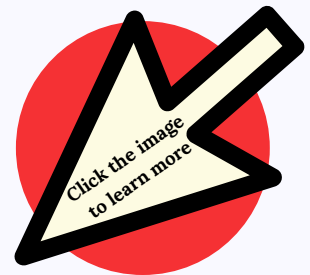




Make and Sell

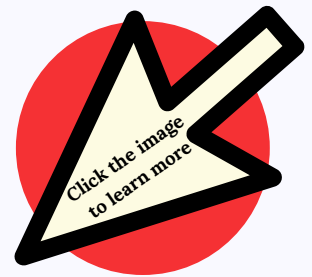
